How to Find the Clitoris, the G-Spot and the Deep-Spot

Don't you think a pussy is the weirdest thing? There's so much going on down there. Where are you supposed to touch? Where are you supposed to lick?

When it comes to pussy, I have a simple philosophy:

I do whatever I feel like doing. I touch whatever I want to touch. And I lick whatever I want to lick.

The pussy is a gift to us men – and I LOVE IT!

But ... What if you want to please your girl? What if you want to give her an orgasm? Then you can't just do whatever you want to do.

The pussy isn't sensitive all over. There are some areas that are way more sensitive than others.

There are three areas that every man should know about. They are all great when you want to give your girl an orgasm. And they are all easy to find.

Finding the Clitoris

Of the three, this one is the most difficult to find. It's hidden, and it can be very small – sometimes smaller than a pea.

The clitoris (glans clitoris) is made of the same tissue as the head of your penis – it's completely smooth. That means, when you see it you won't mistake it for anything else.

The shape and size vary from woman to woman. A small clit usually has a round shape, while a larger clit has the size and shape of a peanut.

The clit is often covered by the clitoral hood (prepuce). The clitoral hood is like your foreskin, and you have to pull it back to see the clit.

So, how do you find the clit?

Have your girl lie on her back with her legs spread. Lick one of your thumbs to make it wet. Then slide your thumb up and down your girl's inner lips.

At the bottom you'll find the vagina opening. And at the top – where the inner lips come together – you'll find the clit.

If the clit is small, it's usually hidden under the clitoral hood. To pull back the clitoral hood, lay your other thumb on the upmost part of your girl's vagina. (Where the outer lips come together.) Then pull your thumb up. (Up against her stomach.)

If your girl's clit is very small, then it may be easier to pinch the clitoral hood between your thumb and your index finger. Pull your fingers up against her stomach, and you should see the clit "pops" out.

Finding the G-Spot

The g-spot is easier to locate. Simply do this:

Insert your middle finger into the vaginal canal with the pad of your finger facing up (if your girl is lying on her back.) About half a finger length in you'll find the g-spot.

Since the pubic bone lies under (or over) the g-spot, it feels hard to the touch.

Often you'll feel that the area is ridged, similar to the ridges on your upper gum. And sometimes it feels like you're touching rice grains.

Don't be surprised if you don't find anything special. The area under your finger *is* the g-spot, regardless of what you feel.

Finding the Deep-Spot

Now that you've found the g-spot, it's even easier to find the deep-spot.

Simply insert your finger all the way inside the vaginal canal. Make sure the pad of your finger face upwards (towards the stomach). The area under your finger pad is called the deep-spot.

The deep-spot feels different than the g-spot.

First, it's soft to the touch – there's no bone under it. Second, it feels like a big flat area. Third, it's usually smooth. (But some women have ridges in this area as well.)

The best way to describe it is to compare it with pressing your finger into a water balloon. That sounds strange, but you'll understand when you find the deep-spot and press your finger into it.

Stimulating the Clitoris, G-Spot and Deep-Spot

The clitoris, the g-spot and the deep-spot are the areas of choice when you want to give your girl an orgasm. But they are not stimulated the same way.
